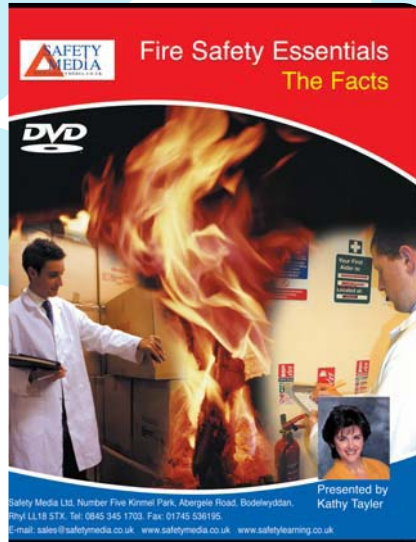


Fire Safety Essentials - The Facts
