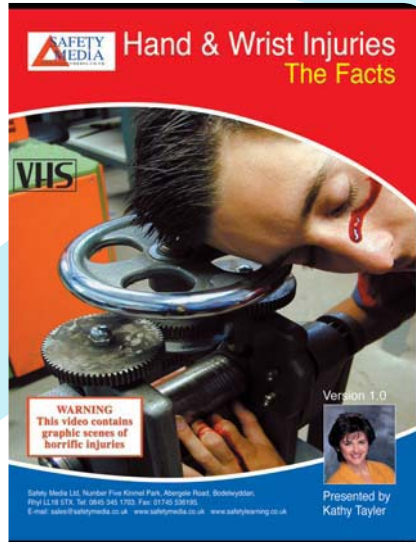




Hand & Wrist Injuries - The Facts
