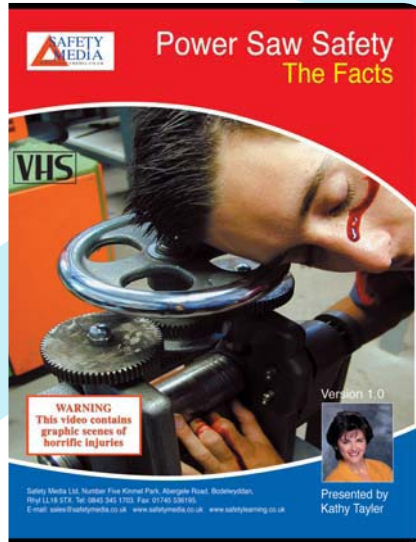




Power Saw Safety - The Facts
