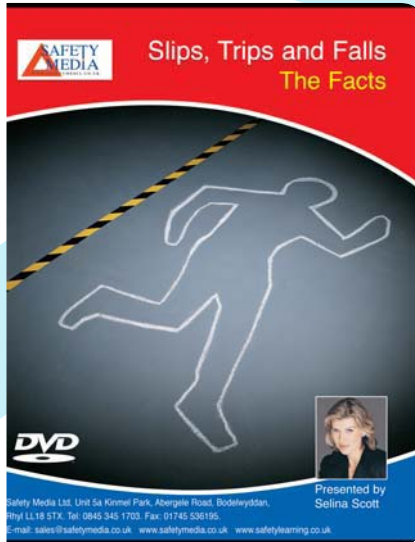


Slips, Trips & Falls - The Facts

Legislation:

The prevention of slips, trips and falls features in a number of different legislation which affects business. It is vital that every employer is aware of this legislation and takes appropriate action to train their employees in the importance of taking care whilst conducting their work.

According to the **Health & Safety at Work Act 1974** "Employers must provide a safe place of work for staff and the general public". While the **Workplace Regulations 1992** require that all floors are suitable, in good condition, free from obstruction so that people can move safely.

The **Management of Health and Safety at Work Regulations 1999** requires employees to "Assess risks associated with slips, trips and falls where necessary take appropriate action to prevent accidents".
